FUR-ST AID:

WHAT YOU CAN DO WHEN THERE IS NO VET

The Seminar, by Vicki **Golden Doodle**, covers basic 1st Aid for Pets. Whether we are at sea, camping on a remote beach or at home in the palapa, emergencies for our animal companians can occur. We will discuss the normal ranges of TPR, evaluating the crisis and responding appropriately to various situations to give emergency and possibly life-saving care. Topics include CPR for dogs and cats, injuries and fractures, toxins, bandaging, and the use of human drugs; those which are safe and those which are highly toxic to animals and should never be given. Participants are invited to share their experiences and concern during a question and answer session which follows.

This is in no way intended as a substitute for professional veterinary care. It is strongly recommended that owners consult with a veterinarian regarding the event that occurred and the emergency care rendered.

Medical Emergencies Services -

Ray **Adios** and Todd **Casa Blanca** have both donated their services to the fleet during the four days of Loreto Fest. Ray is an E.R. Nurse, Todd is a Fire Fighter, and they are willing to assist anyone in need of emergency medical treatment. They are open for business 24 / 7 during the Festival.


Lupita
